However, he had to return to Romania because he was responsible for the distribution of about 800 of the Samaritan's Purse Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes during several children's evangelistic services. So, he returned to Romania and I stayed in Ocala to help his mom continue recuperating until the end of March.

I have to share this story with you....Randy explained that during the Christmas season the Puppet Team presented several children's evangelistic programs around Oradea. In the program, the beautiful story of Baby Jesus' birth is told by the puppets. During the Christmas holidays, one of our pastor friends sat down with his small daughter to explain to her about the true meaning of Christmas (Jesus' birth). She was very young and he had never shared this with her before and thought it was a good time to do so. Well, to his surprise, as he started telling the story she chimed in with him and helped him tell the whole story! He was so shocked that she knew about this and asked her how she knew this story. She quickly replied, "The Puppets told us this story!" He could not believe how his small daughter remembered this story from a puppet program. Randy shared this story with the puppeteers, who are mostly college age students, and they finally realized that they were "ministering" to their own people through puppets! It was like a light bulb finally clicked in their mind. Isn't it amazing how God can use a puppet to share his simple message of love.....?
