

We hope he could complete those by the end of May, but our stay here may be extended several weeks into June.

When he is not training or studying, Austin volunteers at the Missionary Flights International (MFI) hangar. He has loved assisting the mechanics with airplane maintenance and repairs as well as loading, unloading cargo. It's a blessing for him to hear all the stories of how God is working in the Caribbean, through MFI and its associated missionaries.

Austin's training requires focus, and my job of mothering and schooling requires patience and consistency.
