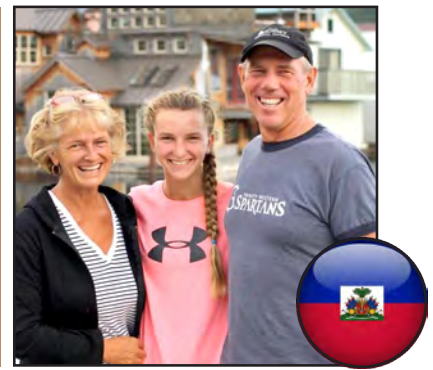
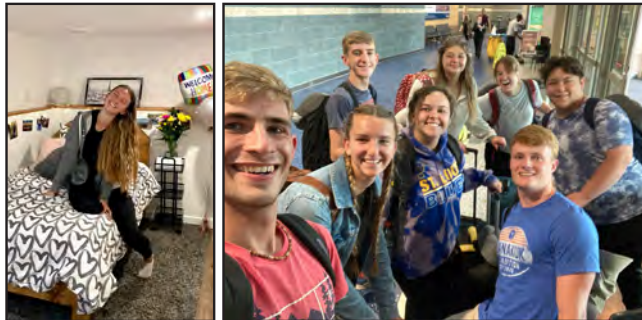


# Camp Mahanaim with The Wray Family Rod, Debbie & Katie
