Greetings Friends and Family,

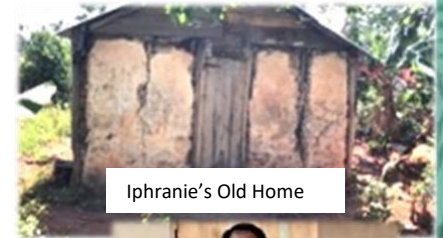

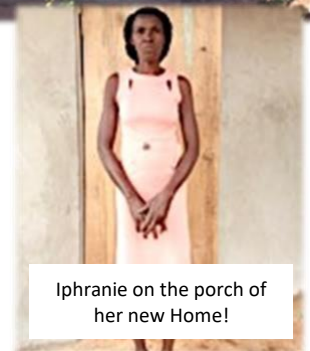
